Doors to my said wife and to her Dispose. I give my servant Peter to my wife, and after her Decease Peter to be set free and be a free Man from all my Heirs. Also I give my said wife ten Pounds of Sheeps Wool Yearly, to be found by my Executor.

Item. I give to my three Daughters, to wit, Sarah Fowler, Mary Bryant and Lucy Martin, to wit: I give to Sarah Fowler and her heirs, the sum of twenty-six Pounds, thirteen shillings and four Pence, and I give to my daughter Mary Bryant the sum of twenty six pounds thirteen shillings and four pence to her and her Heirs forever.

Item. I give to my Daughter Lucy Martin the sum of Twenty-six pounds thirteen shillings and four Pense in full of her Portion.

Item. I give to my son Richard Shatswell all my real and personal Estate, except what is before given away, to him and his heirs forever.

And I do constitute and appoint my son Richard to be my sole executor, &c.
