Elizabeth, bap. Sept. 1, 1745, unm.

Martha, bap. April 10, 1748, m. John Fellows.

John, bap. Oct. 21, 1750, d.e.

Mary, bap. Aug. 13, 1753, m. Simon Smith.

Jonathan, bap. Jan. 16, 1756, d.e.

The will of John 4. is dated 1774, Aug. 22, and reads as follows:

"I give to my well-beloved wife, Elizabeth, the whole of my personal Estate and the Improvement of the whole of my real estate so long as she shall remain my widow. In case of her second marriage she to have the improvement of one third, &c.

I give to my eldest daughter Elizabeth, the whole of my Mansion House and Homestead, which Homestead is bounded north easterly by the street or road leading to Rowley, south east by land of Moses Lords, South west by land late John Fitts, and north west by land of Richard Shatswell. Also one acre of salt Marsh which lies on the Northwardly side of Green's Creek, to be entered upon by her, at her mother's decease or 2d marriage.

Item: I give all the remainder of my estate to my Daughters Martha Fellows and Mary Smith to be equally divided between them.
