


The Linebrook Parish Church
Preservation Agreement

The Linebrook Parish is the owner of the premises of the Linebrook Parish Church on Linebrook Road, Ipswich, Essex County, Massachusetts, bounded and described as shown on Exhibit A, attached hereto. For title see deed of Foster to Inhabitants of Linebrook Parish dated May 24, 1828, and recorded at Essex South District Registry of Deeds, Book 252, Page 124.

1. Subject to the Protective Zoning By-Law of the Town of Ipswich.
2. The Linebrook Parish Church, built in 1848, has been evaluated by the Historical Commission of the Town of Ipswich (the "Commission") as having significant historical architectural value and being especially worthy of preservation. Therefore, to ensure the architectural and historical integrity of the Linebrook Parish Church, and in consideration of no amount paid and such technical advice and assistance as the Commission may render, the Parish hereby agrees for itself and its heirs, grantees, devisees, successors and assigns with the Town of Ipswich not to make alterations nor permit others to make any alterations to the following portions of the premises without prior written approval of the Commission; which permission shall not be unreasonably withheld:
